Definitions

RIT Score

The student's overall score on the test. This is a grade independent measure of item difficulty that ranges from 100-350.

Percentile Rank

The percentage of students in the national norms group for this grade, subject, and test administration season that this student's score equaled or exceeded.

Spring to Spring Growth


An indicator of how much the student's score increased since the previous Fall, compared to other students with similar scores in the same grade and season.

Quantile & Lexile Range

A score (displayed as a 150-point range) resulting from a correlation between NWEA's RIT score and the Quantile or Lexile scale that helps identify reading material that is at an appropriate difficulty level for an individual student.






George's Language Usage score is **above average** compared to 5th graders in the Spring.



Mathematics




George's Math K-12 score is **above average** compared to 5th graders in the Spring.






George's Reading score is **above average** compared to 5th graders in the Spring.
